This day came the parties by their attorneys and the defendant relinquishing  
his plea of debt of Superior dignity and fully administered. and thereupon came a Jury  
to wit, Henry B Vaughan, Allen Taylor, Elijah Terry, Robert B Simmons, Samuel  
Frederick, Benjamin Kiner, James McElhenny, Benjamin Russell, Benjamin Taylor,  
Lewis R. East, H. M. Rogers and Matthew Belmont who being elected to do and swear  
the truth to speak upon the plea of Payment by his estate  
and the Jury brought into Court a verdict in the case and for one following to wit  
Five of the Jury find for the Plaintiff the debt on the declaration, <sup>with interest thereon</sup>  
from the 21<sup>st</sup> November 1809 and award his damages to one pound. Therefore it is  
ordered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover by and the defendant fully satisfy  
the debt of one pound with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of the per centum  
per annum from the Twenty second day of November one thousand eight hundred and  
nine until the time of payment together with their damages as before awarded  
appears and then both by their attorneys about their debts and the benefit of the law  
of the goods and chattels of the defendant in the hands of the defendant if it should  
turn out he hath in his hands to be administered but if not then the debt of one pound  
to be paid of his own proper goods and chattels and the said defendant in many

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
