This day came the Parties by their attorneys and thereupon came also a Jury to wit: Alexander Myrick, Hyschiah Bligars, Branch McNeill, James Foster, Henry Melch, Henry B. Vaughan, John H. Chapman, William V. Daughtrey, Henry Johnson, Matthew Balch, James Pierce and Henry Bailey who being sworn the truth to speak upon the Issue joined, brought into Court a Verdict in the words following to wit: "We of the Jury find for the Plaintiff the debt in the declaration mentioned. Subject to a credit for fifty dollars, paid on the Twentieth day of December 1885 and upon his damages to one party." Therefore it is the order of the Court that the Plaintiff recover against the defendants Eighteen hundred and Sixty dollars and Ten Cents the debt aforesaid with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of Six per centum per annum from the Twentieth day of March 1886 until the time of payment, and his costs and charges as aforesaid. Such in this behalf expenses to be paid of the goods and chattels of the defendant and the heirs of the defendant if so much thereof he be to be administrator but not more than the debt aforesaid to be paid of his own proper goods and chattels and the said defendant in money &c. Subject to the credit aforesaid.
