This day came the parties by their attorneys and the defendants relinquishing his plea of debt of Superior equity fully administered and he agreed to pay, therefore came also by the Court, James Prescott, Thomas Lemmon, William Parsons, James Lemmon, George Cook, James Wolfson, David Barker, Robert J Lemmon, Richard Richard, Henry Johnson, James Millikin and Howard Myrick who being sworn the truth to speak upon the issues joined upon the third plea of payment by intestate brought into Court a Voucher in the following words to wit: "We of the above first for the Plaintiff the debt on the declaration mentioned and upon his demand to wit: That the said Defendant by the Court that the Plaintiff received as against the defendant forty four dollars and twenty five cents the debt aforesaid - which interest thereon to be computed after the rate of six per centum per annum from the day of November 1813 until the time of payment, to which both he demanded in full aforesaid of the said Defendant and the Court by him about his debt in this behalf expenses and the said Defendant in money &c. But this sum of money is to be exchanged by the payment of twenty four dollars and twenty five cents with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of six per centum per annum from the first day of January 1812 until the time of payment, and the Court himself expenses to be taxed of the goods and chattels of the defendant in the hands of the defendant and if so much should he hath to be administered. But if not then the Court aforesaid to be taxed by his own proper goods and chattels and the said Defendant in money &c."
