Blunt, Martha P. Blunt, Mary W. Blunt and John W. Blunt orphans of William
Blunt deceased. The day returned an account of each of the said orphans estate which
was examined and allowed by the Court. - (also ordered to be recorded)

On the motion of David Robinson the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth
in the Superior Court of Law to be held in for this County, for the consent of the
Court to alter the time of holding the said Court to the first day of April and the
first day of September in each year instead on the seventh of the said month
in each year. The Court have his objection that the time of holding the said
Superior Court be changed so that the same be held first day of April and the first
day of September in each year as proposed. Which is ordered to be entered of Court.

On the motion of Joris and Rewards who made oaths and together with William
Loway and Ichabod Johnson his Committee entered into and acknowledges a bond
