

would following to wit "We the Jury find that the defendant did at the time of the exhibition of the Complaint filed in this cause hold possession of the Tenement therein mentioned against the Consent of the Plaintiff, that the said Defendant hath & holds possession thereof against the Consent of the Plaintiff for three years next before the exhibition of his Complaint and that the Plaintiff hath the right of possession in the Tenement aforesaid." Therefore It is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover against the defendant possession of the Tenement aforesaid & that his Costs be him in this behalf expensed. And a writ of Habere possessionem him returnable here &c —
