The Defendant Thomas Parker and Savannah Barlow not having entered their appearance and given Security according to the act of the General Assembly and the rules of this Court, and it appearing to the bare faction of the Court that they are not inhabitants of this Commonwealth. Therefore It is Considered by the Court and accordingly ordered that they appear here on or before the third Monday in December next and answer the Complamants bill, and that a copy of this order be forthwith inserted in the Pittsburgh Intelligencer for two months successively and posted at the front door of the Court house of this County on two several Court days.

Ordered that process issue against George Drake to cause him to appear here on the first day of November Court next to answer the remonstrance the day made against him.

On the petition of Richard Munfer setting forth (that he is anxious to erect a saw mill and mill on the stream, a water course called Many Branches in the said County of Southampton, that he is the owner of the land on both sides of the water courses against which he intends to abut his dam and that the use of the said water course all belongs to himself) Therefore It is ordered that a writ of re quo dammum be issued directed to the Sheriff of this County, commanding him to summon, and impanel twelve fit persons to meet upon the lands so prepared for the abutment on the third day of October next who shall be charged by the said Sheriff impartially and to the best of their skill and judgment, to view the said lands so prepared for the abutment, and to locate and circumference by certain rods and bounds, one acre thereof, having due regard thereto to the interest of both parties, and to appraise the same according to its true value, to examine the lands above and below of the property of others, which may probably be overfow, and say to what damage it will be of the several proprietors, or the offices, buildings or other domains immediately belonging, or otherwise will be overfow, to adjuudicating whether in what species fish of passage are necessary protection will be granted, and whether in their opinion the health of the neighbors will be annoyed by the vagaries of the water. And that the inquest so to be made and sealed by the said Jurors, together with this writ, be returned by the said Sheriff to the next Court.
