Upon the Petition of Livia Root and others setting forth that they are bound as Trustees for Samuel Talbot his due and faithful administration on the said Estate of Matthew Talbot deceased, and that they apprehend themselves to be in danger of suffering damage by their being bound as aforesaid. It is therefore ordered that the said Samuel Talbot be Summoned to the next Court to give Counter Security for administration aforesaid.

Upon the Petition of Richard Darsent. It is ordered that the ferry between Brown Ferry be kept free, as to all the People residing in this County. The bond contracting to pay unto the said Richard Darsent the sum of one hundred and forty Dollars annually, for and during the term of five years next ensuing.

Abraham Reese is appointed Guardian to Rivers Reese orphan of Sally Reese deceased, who together with John Reese Jr and Anne Threlkeld his Parents entered into and acknowledged a bond in the Penalty of five thousand Dollars with Condition according to Law.

Allen Dole of this County deceased who was intestate possessed of a small Estate in which no person will administer. It is ordered that the Sheriff take the said decedent's Estate into his hands and as soon thereof as the Law directs also return an account to the Court.
