Ordered that Josiah Williams be summoned to the next court to show Cause if any he have why his Heirs not be bound for the payment of his taxes and dues, this year.

Be it remembered that Robert Magee with John Davis and Benjamin Love his Sureties here in Court, acknowledge themselves to be severally indebted unto his Excellency William Bay Nicholas Esqr Governor or Chief magistrate of this Commonwealth and his Successors in Office, the said Robert Magee in the sum of One hundred Dollars, and the said John Davis and Benjamin Love in the sum of fifty dollars each of their respective lands and Tenements, goods and Chattels to be levied, and to the said Governor or his Successors in Office, upon this Condition, that if the said Robert Magee shall keep the Peace, and be of good behaviour towards all the Citizens of this Commonwealth more especially towards John Bryant for the Term of Six months from this day then this recognizance to be Void.

Ordered that William D Powell and wife be summoned to the next court to answer an account demanded of the administration on the Estate of Joseph Turner deceased.

Ordered that John D Powell and wife be summoned to the next court to answer an account of their administration on the Estate of Henry Smith deceased.

Be it remembered that John Bryant with Andrew Mow and Nelson Make his Sureties here in Court, severally acknowledge themselves to be severally indebted unto his Excellency William Bay Nicholas Esqr Governor or Chief magistrate of this Commonwealth that is to say the said John Bryant in the sum of one hundred Dollars and the said Andrew Mow and Nelson Make each in the sum of fifty Dollars, of their respective lands and Tenements, goods and Chattels to be levied and to the said Governor and his Successors in Office, for the use of the Commonwealth's services, yet upon this Condition that if the said John Bryant shall keep the Peace, and be of good behaviour towards all the legal People of this Commonwealth, more especially towards Robert Magee for the Term of Six months, for this day, then this recognizance to be Void.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the Court in June
