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As the motion of Henry Melch, leave is given him to build a Piggan on
the Public Ground, in front of the store house now occupied by him, so that the
said Piggan shall not extend farther than the Piggan is the dwelling house of
the said Melch —

Henry Briggs is by the court appointed Treasurer to Elizabeth Nea Clerk of
Robert Nea, whereupon the said Briggs together with William Briggs the
Treasurer entered into and acknowledge a bond in the Penalty of Two hundred
Dollars, with Condition according to Law —
