Henry Brigg is by the Court appointed guardian to Elizabeth Rea child Robert Rea, Whereupon the said Henry Brigg together with William B. his Security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of hundred dollars, with condition according to Law -

Upon the petition of Richard Mumfer for leave to build a water grist and Saw Mill and dam on the Missy Branch; This day came the said Richard Mumfer and the Sheriff returned an Inquisition, taken pursuant to a writ of Ad, quod damnum to him issued, which Inquest is in these words,

"Agreeably to a writ of ad, quod damnum to erect a Mill on the Missy by Richard Mumfer, we the Jury have met on the premises viewed and examined the Stream above and below and find that no individual sustains any damages but the said Richard Mumfer who owns in fee simple the Land on both sides above and below the said abutment where the said Mill is intended to be erected, also one acre of Land attached to the

"abutment belongs in fee simple to the said Richard Mumfer. We have taken into consideration whether the health of the neighbours will be annoyed by the raising of the water, and do say in our opinion that the health of them will not be impaired, we further say that the said Mumfer may hold off feet of water on the sheet if he chooses. Given under our hands and Seal this 3rd day of October 1816.
