

3) Bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars, with conditions according to Law -

Edward A Branch is by the Court assigned guardian to Joseph W Summerell orphan of Henry Summerell deceased whereupon the said Edward A Branch together with Samuel Pond and John Butler his Securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars with condition according to Law -

Pettway Johnson is by the Court assigned guardian to Nancy Luter orphan of John Luter deceased whereupon the said Pettway Johnson together with Jonathan Luter his Security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars, with condition according to Law -

James Hlayton is by the Court assigned guardian to John Luter orphan of John Luter deceased, whereupon the said James Hlayton together with Jonathan Luter and Herrod Summerell his Securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars, with condition according to Law -

Herrod Summerell is by the Court assigned guardian to Abas Luter orphan of John Luter deceased whereupon the said Herrod Summerell together with Benjamin Butler and James Hlayton his Securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars, with condition according to Law -

On the motion of Spencer Jenkins who made oath and together with Lewis M Branch and Samuel J Boykin his Securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars. Conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted the said Spencer Jenkins for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Ann Jenkins in due form -

Ordered that Willis Bowen, John Butler, Simon Boykin and Peter Purcell or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace of this County do well and truly appraise in current money all the personal Estate of Ann Jenkins deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to the Court -
