the bar by the Sheriff of this County, into whose custody he was heretofore
committed. Charged with having on the 9 of October last. Post breaking the house
of William D. Powell and shooting & stealing, taking and carrying away sundry
articles the property of the said William D. Powell of this County. The Summons
for his examination and trial not having met. Now at this day came several
witnesses who appeared on behalf of the Commonwealth, were sworn and charged
and examining touching the premises, to wit William J. Smith, Ezekiel, Mason and
Arthur. The after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of
opinion that the prisoner is not guilty of the crime that he stands charged thereof
It is ordered that the said Prisoner be forthwith discharged from his imprisonment

On the motion of Phoebe Myrick who made oath and together with James
Harris and George J. J. her Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond
in the Penalty of Fifteen Thousand Dollars conditioned as the Law directs
Certificate is granted her for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of
