The Court Summoned for his examination failing to attend, (now at a day three witnesses appeared and were sworn and examined on behalf the Commonwealth to wit,

The Court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case, are of opinion that the Prisoner is not guilty of the charge whereof he stands charged. Therefore it is ordered that he be forthwith discharged from his imprisonment

This defendant appeared in Court according to the condition of his recognizance into for a breach of the Peace alleged against him by the said John Shepherd. Whereupon sundry witnesses being sworn and examined and the said Mayr being fully heard, It is the opinion of the Court and accordingly, that the said Joel Mayr give Security for his good behavior for term of Twelve months, that is to say, himself in the sum of Two hundred dollars with two Securities to be bound with him in the sum of One hundred dollars each. Whereupon the said Joel Mayr with Lewis Jolly and Thomas Williamson, his Securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to his Excellency Wilson Cary Nicholas Esquire Governor or Chief Magistrate of this Commonwealth, the said Joel Mayr in the sum of Two hundred dollars, and the said Lewis Jolly and Thomas Williamson in the sum of one hundred dollars each, of their respective lands and Tenement goods and chattels to be levied, and to said Governor and his Successors in Office for the use of the Commonwealth. Yet upon this condition that if the said Joel Mayr shall be more especially a man of good behavior towards all the Citizens of this Commonwealth as aforesaid, then this recognizance to be void
