This day this Cause was admitted by Consent of the Parties and report of the Court Cause on to be heard upon the Bill of the Complainants, answers of the defendants and arguments of Counsel, Whereupon, And after due consideration thereof has the Court doth decree order and adjudge, that Benjamin Blunt John Faircloth, Newet Harris and Miles look on any three of them, to be attended with the Surveyor of this County of Maryland, do lay off and divide into two equal parts the tract of Land whereof the said Thomas Porter died seized and possessed and apportion and set a part by proper meter and bounds one of the said Parts of Land unto the Complainant John Porter and the other Part to the Complainant Thomas Porter having regard to quality as well as quantity, And that the said Commissioners or such of them as may act, do lay off into three equal parts, all the Slaves belonging to the estate of the said deceased and allot and apportion the same equally between the remaining Complainants Richard Porter, Susan Porter and Mary Porter or to their executors or next friends, having regard to the value of the said Slaves. And it is further ordered that the said Commissioners or such of them as act make a report to the Court of their actings and doings in this behalf, in order to a final Decree.
