

Ordered that John Fitzhugh, Levy Waller, Nelson Pope and Edwin Turner or any
three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace, do with and truly
appraise in current money all the Personal Estate of John Fitzhugh deceased
and return the appraisement under their hands to the Court

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County into whose hands the Estate of Solomon
Turner deceased hath been committed, Pay to John Longhart the Sum of one hundred
and forty Seven dollars and Thirty and a half cents, the amount of his account, and
return an account thereof to the Court, according to law, also the Sum of 62 cents cost of
his motion

Ordered that Elias Sumner, Charles Holleman, and Samuel G. Boykins or any
two of them, do examine State and Tolls the account of the administration of
the Estate of Charles Williamson deceased and make a report thereof to the Court

Hubbard a negro man Slave, the property of Fanny alias Fanny Blow
a free girl of color, was this day Set at the bar in Custody of the Sheriff of
County, into whose Custody he was heretofore committed, charged with, murdering
of a negro man Slave the property of James Barnett of this County, on the 2nd
of this present month, (The Court of Oyer and Terminer, which was summoned for
trial not having met) Therefore being arraigned, and pleaded not guilty, and
was heard by Counsel in his own defense, Whereupon divers Witnesses were sworn
charged and examined, on behalf of the Commonwealth, touching the Premises, to wit
Wells a negro man Slave the property of Amos Stephenson, of full age deposes and
says, that he was at the Kitchen of Henry Thomas of this County, that next the
decedent, came to the Kitchen and asked Hubbard the Prisoner at the bar for
some money which he owed him, he the Prisoner told West he had not the money
and quarrelled there ensued, and Hubbard the Prisoner at the bar stripped himself
to fight and called West the decedent a Damned rascal, West the decedent then
told Hubbard the Prisoner, West then drew back his fist to strike Hubbard
and told him not to repeat it, if he did that he would strike him, Hubbard
the Prisoner, then made a pass at West the decedent, he this deponent then
heard some persons say Hubbard had a knife, and he this deponent caught West
to pull him away, and as Hubbard made the second pass at him meaning West,
he cut this deponent upon the arm, West then said, that Hubbard had
struck him, West then turned to the light and this deponent then saw his
wounds in his hands and further this deponent said that, Betty a negro
woman Slave, the property of Henry Thomas being of full age deposes and
says, that she knows nothing at all about the matter, between the Commonwealth
and the Prisoner and further this deponent says that, Willis a negro man the
property of George Shiley, of full age, deposes and says, that next the
decedent asked Hubbard for some money which he owed him, Hubbard said he
had none, and an affray ensued between Hubbard and West, and he saw Hubbard
make a stroke at West, and West then said Hubbard had cut him, he this
deponent looked at West and saw his intestines out which the decedent held
