tomorrow

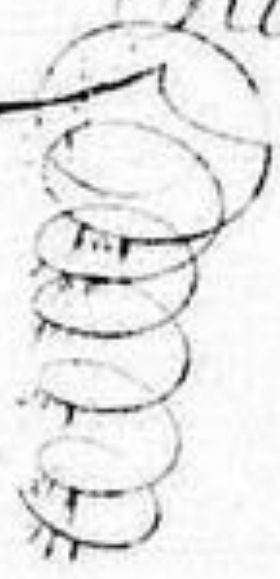
John Blythe who stands bound by recognizance to appear here this day to answer
