This day came the parties and the commissioners heretofore appointed, to make
sale of certain Slaves in the bill mentioned. This day made their report in the words
and figures following (to wit) "January 9th 1817. Agreeable to the above orders to
us directed we have made Sale of the Slaves belonging to the Estate of Matthew
Parker deceased, and made distribution as directed in said order except the proportion
due Thomas Parker and Susanna Barlow who are inhabitants of the State of Georgia
we have therefore returned the said Barlow and Parker bonds to Court for your
Honours to direct how they shall be disposed of. From under our hands this 6th
day of February 1817 Rich^d. P. Clements Benjamin Munn, Randolph Owsen"
Whereupon by Consent of the parties It is decreed and ordered, that the distribution
made as aforesaid be held firm, stable and binding between the parties and that the
costs be proportionably borne between them

Grogg Sheriff of this County, and that he administer Debtor's now then on according
to Law

Ordered that David Newsome Guardian to Susan J. Lindsay orphan of James
Lindsay deceased be summoned to May Court next, to show Cause if any he can
why he should not be displaced from the guardianship aforesaid, and another
guardian be appointed to the said orphan
