The persons appointed Commissioners on this case, this day made their
report in the words and figures following to wit

Agreeable to an order of the County Court of Southampton to us directed
bearing date August Court 1816 we the undersigned have gone on the lands of
Jacob Vick decd attended with the surveyor of Southampton County as by the
order we were required and Surveyed the same and find the number of acres
in each tract to be as follows, in the tract wherein the said Jacob Vick formerly
lived, including the land of William Ferguson which is within the out bound of the
said land the pt of 340 acres in the tract beyond Benjamin Jordan 85 acres
in the tract of land lying on the north side of Nottoway River 90 acres making
in all the lands belonging to Jacob Vick decd 515 acres which separate tracts
of land we have divided in manner and form following, to wit Say Lot
No 1 in the tract wherein Jacob Vick formerly lived containing 42 1/2 acres amount
by Patience Jordan which lot was valued at \$2.25 ft. acre amounting to \$95.62 1/2
being her full Proportionable Part of all the lands of the said decd lying on
the south side of Nottoway River after receiving from lot No 2 being Lemuel
Vick lot the sum of \$30.91 and from Exors Vick lot the sum of \$55.15 which
respective sums added together makes \$181.68 1/2 then parts of the lands of Jacob
Vick decd lying as aforesaid and bounded as follows Beginning at a post
oak a corner of Williams Busters thence S. 29. E. 30 pole to a Variation on the line
thence S. 85. E. 60 pole to a Post oak, Variation, thence S. 63. E. 40 Pole another
Variation, thence along a short dividing line N. 75. E. 12 pole to a corner tree on
the side of a path in Fergusons line, thence bounded by Fergusons line to a
Cross a new Corner made in his out boundary line, thence along a dividing
line of Lots No. 142 & 43. N. 38 pole to a new corner made in same
line, thence along his line of marked trees to the First Station,
including Patience Jordans Proportionable part of all the lands of Jacob Vick
decd lying on the south side of Nottoway River aforesaid
Also Lot No. 2 bounded as follows to wit. Beginning at a new Corner
made in Fergusons line thence along Fergusons line to a new Corner made
