Joseph Orr Faircloth is by the Court assigned Guardian to Robert Brynne orphan of Ursula Brynne decd. Whereupon the said Joseph Orr together with Turner, Edwards and Jones Edwards his Trustees entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Six hundred dollars, with condition according to Law.

Lutia Porter is by the Court exempt in future from payments of the taxes on her negro woman Sarah, she being aged and infirm.

This day came the Parties by their attorneys and the defendant acknowledged the Plaintiff's action for eighty dollars the debt in the declaration mentioned. Therefore with the assent of the Plaintiff it is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said eighty dollars, and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended. And the said defendant is to be discharged by the payment of forty dollars, with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of Six per centum per annum from the 25th of December 1815 till paid, and the costs.

Charles Cook Exor of Bennett Taylor and... Plt.

against Wells Brown and John Priest. In debt

This day came the Parties by their attorneys, and the defendant acknowledged the Plaintiff's action for sixteen pounds the debt in the declaration mentioned. Therefore with the assent of the Plaintiff it is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said sixteen pounds, the debt above said, and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended. And the said defendant is to be discharged by the payment of eight pounds with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of Six per centum per annum from the 25th day of Decr 1815 till the time of payment, and the costs.
