The persons appointed commissioners in this case this day made their report in the words and figures following to wit "Agreeable to an Act of the Court June Court 1816 we the undersigned subscribers have divided the lands formerly belonging to James Browne decd containing 102 1/2 acres of which to the County of Hampshire, Fanny Nelson and Lot No 1 adjoining the lands of Barton Taylor, John Boylens, James Boylens and the dividing line between Elizabeth Browne Lot marshes, two containing forty nine acres, out to pay James Browne thirty dollars on demand from this date, Lot No 2 drawn by Elizabeth Browne containing twenty nine acres adjoining the lands of Richard Williamson James Taylor, the dividing line between Lot No 2 & 3 Barton Taylor and Lot No 412. Lot No 3 containing twenty four and a half acres drawn by James Browne and bounded by the following lines to wit the dividing lines of Lot No 2 & 3 the lines of Barton Taylor and James Taylor and to receive from Fanny Nelson thirty dollars on demand from this date. Given under our hands this 26th day of June 1816 - Dr. Partridge, Dueser Torgerson, Commissioners by Consent of the Court It is decreed and ordered that the foregoing report be here from and stable between the parties and that the costs of preparation be taken therefrom."
