This day came the Parties by their attorneys, and thereupon came also a Jury to wit, Henry Parker, Nathl. Knight, Elisha Williams, Bolling B. Barrett, Henry Johnson, Lewis Water and Willis Worville who being elected, read and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue joined, brought here into Court a verdict in the following words to wit: "We the Jury find for the Plaintiff and award his damages to thirty three dollars and fifty cents with interest thereon from the 24th of October 1814. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover of the defendant the sum of thirty two dollars and fifty cents with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of six per Centum per annum from the 24th day of October 1814. The said damages aforesaid in form aforesaid, apportioned and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended, to be paid of the goods and chattels of the defendant in the hands of the defendant, to be administered if so much thereof he hath if not then the Court aforesaid to be paid of his own proper goods and chattels and the said defendant in mercy &c."

This day came the parties by their attorneys, and on the motion of the defendant by their attorney who filed their Special plea in writing and the Pt. by his attorney their replication thereto thereupon issue being joined came also a Jury to wit, Henry Parker, Elisha Williams, Bolling B. Barrett, Henry Johnson, Elisha Williams, Henry Johnson, Lewis Water and Richard D. Aaron who being elected, read and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue aforesaid joined brought here into Court a verdict in the following words to wit: "We of the Jury find for the Plaintiff and award his damages to sixteen dollars with interest thereon from the 24th day of October 1814." Therefore it is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff take nothing by his bill but for his faults blameless in mercy &c. And that the defendant go thereof without day and recover against the said Plaintiff three dollars damages and his costs by him about his defence in this behalf expended, to be paid of the goods and chattels of the defendant in the hands of the Plaintiff to be administered if so much thereof he hath if not then the Court aforesaid to be paid of his own proper goods and chattels and the said Plaintiff in mercy &c."
