and part of the Estate of Henry Smith and hath been committed, pay to
Henry White the Sum of Nine dollars and Twenty five Cents. To John
White the Sum of Three dollars and fifty Cents. To Thomas Malone five dollars
and fifty Cents. the amount of their accounts. - also 62 Cents each part of money
and make a return thereof to the Court

Ordered that Samuel Balcut Executor of Matthew Balcut and his
Sureties to the next Court. to give, to James Madokun and Henry Smith
counter Surety. they apprehending themselves to be in danger of suffering
damages, by their being Surety for his due and faithful performance of his
executorial proceedings. aforesaid

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until tomorrow
morning 10 O'clock
