This day made their report in the words and figures following to wit: "Southampton County in the County of the within decree of the County Court of Southampton to us directed we have laid off by proper meter and bounds of the land whereof Charles Stephenson died seized and parcel, and the same to the widow to wit Beginning at Hendersonwood line on branch thence down the branch to a gum, thence up the branch to Robert Williams line, thence up Williams line to Hendersonwood thence along the same to the beginning. Also one third part of \$1983.62 being the amount of the personal estate of Charles Stephenson given under our hands this 17th day of February 1817 John James Barrett, John Carr" Whereupon it is decreed and ordered by Court that the foregoing report be held firm stable and binding between the parties, and that the costs be proportionably borne between them.

An Inventory and appraisement of the Estate of William [unclear] was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

An account Current of the Estate of Charles Stephenson was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

An account Current of the Estate of Lewis Williams was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

The commissioners heretofore appointed to set in conjunction the repairs of Black water bridge. This day made their report in the words and figures following to wit: "Agreeable to an order of the Court of Southampton, in its directed date - - - - - and Process agreeable to order to let the repairs of Black water bridge be done with the Commissioners appointed in the County of Southampton for the same purpose, in the year 1816.
