

Livy Walter foreman, Bunuel Beale, Asaphus Whitehead, Josiah Ferguson, Augustine Pope, Leonard Cobb, Nelson Pope, William Francis, James Britt, Joseph Buxton, John Britton, Sand Pond, James Mills, Jesse Parker, Peter Simmons, Samuel Gynnes, Richard B Day and William West being called and appearing were sworn a Grand Jury of Inquests upon the body of this County and after receiving their charge were sent out of Court, and after some time returned and proceeded as follows to wit

"John Bucklew Surveyor of the roads from Jerusalem to the fork of the road at New bottom for failing to keep a sign post erected at the fork thereof which lead to Joe Vicks, by the information of Sand Pond and William West two of our body"

"Griffin Stuck Surveyor of the road, from the fork of the road near James Milliken to Jones mill for not keeping the same in repair according to law by the information of Asaphus Whitehead, Jesse Parker, Joseph Buxton and James Britt four of our body"

"Henry Vaughan owner of the road from Jones mill to the Swan Swamp for not keeping the same in repair according to law by the information of Asaphus Whitehead, Jesse Parker, Joseph Buxton and James Britt of our body"

William Swartney, John Hargrave and Henry Gardner who were summoned to appear here this day as grand jury men, were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that that they severally make them fine with his Excellency James O. Preston Esq: Governor or Chief magistrate of this Commonwealth by the payment of eight dollars each to the use of the said Commonwealth, unless sufficient cause of their inability to attend, be shown at this or the next Court

William B. Goodridge, Lotkin Kitchen and Joshua Fort, and by the Court recommended to his Excellency James O. Preston Esq: Governor or Chief magistrate of this Commonwealth, as able and proper persons to examine, adjust, state and settle the accounts of the former Trustees of the Mottoway and Cravenmond Tribe of Indians

Robert Rich and William Henry by recognizance to appear here this day to answer the Complaint of Elizabeth Vicks against them for a breach of the Peace, appeared accordingly and the Prosecutors being solemnly called but came not and nothing appearing or being alleged against the said Rich & Henry it is ordered that they be discharged from this prosecution

An Inventory and appraisement of the Estate of Sally Barham deceased was this day returned and ordered to be recorded
