

Ordered that Joshua Fort, John T. Blow, Collins Kitchens and Jamin: Nothelle or any three of them, view the ground through which the road is proposed to be turned from the Bridge at Jerusalem to James Suppant's gate and report to the Court the conveniences and inconveniences that will result as well to the Commonwealth as to individuals if the said road shall be opened as proposed.

Ordered that Simon Overlee, be added to the Commissioners heretofore appointed to Superintend the building and erection of a draw arch to the bridge over Black water River at South gray, and that he together with the aforesaid Commissioners or such of them as may act make a report thereof to the Court.

Benjamin Blunt Surg. account of himself and Richard How deceased who was associated with the mill owners of Henry Blow and for the benefit of Richard Remond account. Debts now of Thomas D. Price deceased.

Sept. Tracy Surg. Mizon of himself and Baker Joyner -- Debt. By consent of the parties by their attorneys and with the assent of the Court it is ordered that this Suit be dismissed.

Ordered that George Himes, Edward Battle & Gideon Bell or any two of them view the ground where the road is proposed to be changed from the upper end or corner of Benjamin's lot to lane fence, and that they report to the Court the conveniences and inconveniences that will result as well to the public as to individuals if the said road is straightened & changed as contemplated.

Ordered that Benjamin Blunt Sr. be exempted in future from the payment of Taxes and Levies of his negroes Dillan Rachel, Sarah Fabb, Pegg and Rhoda, they being aged and infirm.

Ordered that Richard O. Clements be exempt in future from the payment of the Taxes and Levies of his negroesman Jacob, he being aged and infirm.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent money in his hands pay to Thomas Ritter Seventy five dollars the amount of his account for repairs done to the upper Tracoch Bridge and account therefor with the Court.
