

1899 one third of the purchase money to be paid on first day of January 1899 at which time possession to be given and secured another third the 1st of January 1900 and the remaining third on the 1st day of January 1900 the purchaser giving bond to the Commissioners with such security as they shall appoint for the payment of the purchase money. which bond shall be taken in this manner. Each of the installments of one third to be divided into four equal parts and a bond taken for each part separately, one of which by the said Commissioners transferred to the guardian of the above mentioned children of Aaron Thapre and another of the said bond and at each of the said periods be in like manner transferred to the Complainant Moses Thapre and each of the other defendants John Thapre and Randolph Thapre and Lewis Jones, Celia Reed, George Key and ^{John} Bachman, are hereby appointed Commissioners for the purpose of carrying this decree into effect, who or any three of whom having done so, are directed to report their proceedings in the premises to this Court in order to a final decree —

This Cause coming on to be heard on the bill and answer the Court on consideration thereof, doth adjudge, order and decree that Henry Briggs and Thomas D. Heath, do see the tract or parcel of land of which a division is prayed in the said Bill and answer, upon such terms and in such manner as to them in their discretion may seem most expedient and that one half of the purchase money for which the said land may be sold be by them allotted to the defendants and the other half be again divided into two equal parts one of which to be allotted to each of the Complainants and the above Commissioners, having carried this decree into effect, are hereby directed to report their proceedings in the premises, to this Court in order to a final decree

Polly Haulcom who was Transmuted to James Comiter Secured for her due and faithful administration on the Estate of Richard Haulcom and this day appeared in Court and together with Lewis Holt and William Williams her Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars, Condition as the law directs — whereupon her former Sureties from their undertaking (from this time) are discharged —

Thos. Nicholson orphan of Charles S. Nicholson and made known of Howell Nicholson and the agent of the Court to be his guardian whereupon the said Howell Nicholson together with Chasmon Nicholson and Nathaniel Nicholson his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars with Condition according to law
