On the motion of Elizabeth Vick who here personally comes into Court
 and complains ^{upon oath} for this that she is apprehensive and as apprehensive some damage
 to be done her, either by or through the said Robert Rich. Whereupon the Court
 after fully hearing the case are of opinion that the said Robert Rich. is
 bound to keep the peace towards all the large people of this Commonwealth
 but more especially towards the said Elizabeth Vick, for twelve calendar months
 from this day hereof in the sum of five hundred dollars and two Securities
 in the sum of two hundred and fifty each and in default thereof that
 he be committed to the Gaol of this County. Whereupon the said Robert Rich. &
 together with Robert Rich. Junr and William Rich. his Securities here in Court
 acknowledge themselves to be indebted unto his excellency James O. Parson Esqr.
 Governor or Chief Magistrate of this Commonwealth. The said Robert Rich. in
 the sum of five hundred dollars and the said Robert Rich. & William
 Rich. each in the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to be taken of their
 respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements, to the use of the Commonwealth.
 And upon this Condition that if the said Robert Rich. shall keep
 the peace and be of good behaviour towards all the large people of this
 Commonwealth, but more especially towards the said Elizabeth Vick for the
 space of Twelve calendar months from this day then the above obligation
 and recognizance to be void else to remain in full force and virtue

Richard O. Clements this day produced to the Court a Commission
 appointing him High Sheriff of this County. who together with approved Security
 entered into and acknowledged three Several bonds as the law directs,
 which is made to be entered of record.

Aubin Middleton this day produced to the Court a Commission
 appointing him a Coroner in & for the County of Southampton. whereupon
 the said Aubin Middleton together with Benjamin Griffin and Benj.
 both his Securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty
 of Ten thousand dollars. Condition as the law directs. Whereupon the said Aubin
 Middleton took the Several oaths prescribed by law.

Aubin Middleton this day produced to the Court a Commission
 appointing him Justice in this County. who together with Benjamin Griffin
 and Benjamin both his Securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in
 the penalty of Ten thousand dollars with Condition &c. Whereupon the
 said Aubin took the oaths prescribed by law.
