The jurors heretofore appointed to make sale of the tract of land in the
last mentioned, this day made their report in the words and figures following to
the Court. "Agreeably to the within decree to us directed, we the undersigned
have made sale of the tract of land therein mentioned, and have allotted
the purchase money as the said decree directs, given under our hands
this 15th day of December 1817. Henry Briggs, Thomas D. Heath." Whereupon
by consent of the parties it is decreed and ordered by the Court that the foregoing
sale be held firm stable and binding between the parties and that the costs be
apportionally borne between them

The last will and Testament of John Prince and was proved by the
oath of John Fort, Isaac Bensall and Horace Nicholson the witnesses thereto and
ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Joseph Prince one of the executor
therein named (the other refusing in open Court to join in the probate) whom made
oath thereto and together with Horace Nicholson, Henry M. Williams and Richard
C. Briggs his Securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of
Twenty Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, Certificate is granted the said
Joseph for obtaining a probate thereof in due form

Ordered that Isaac Bensall, John Nicholson, William Mapenburgh,
Henry Mason and Alexander P. Pette or any three of being first sworn by a
Justice of the Peace do well and truly appraise in current money all the personal
estate of John Prince and return the appraisement under their hands to the Court.
