also allotted to Eliza A. H. Collier, the other third part of the said slaves, to wit,
Lucy and Child, Herbert and Spentay. Given under our hands this 20th
day of December 1875 - Jere. Cobb, Edward Butts, Simon J. Bell, Commissioners.
It is agreed and ordered by the Court with the consent of the parties that
the foregoing report be held firm stable and binding between these parties and that the
be proportionally born between them.

Whereas Pope guardian to James W. Beale, orphan of William Beale dec.
has returned an account of said guardianship, which was examined and allowed
by the Court sworn to by the guardian and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Wilson Davis, one of the executors named in the last
will and Testament of John Davis dec. who made oath thereof and together with
John Dineen and Thomas Jones, his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond
in the penalty of fifteen thousand dollars, to wit as the law directs, Antepate is
granted the said Wilson Davis, for obtaining a probat thereof in due form
the other executors named in the said will which was proved and recorded at the last
Court, refuses here in Court to join in the probat.

Ordered that Burwell Williams, Kinchen Williams, Daniel Williams
and Thomas Pettow, or any three of them being first sworn, do well and truly
appraise in current money all the personal Estate of John Davis dec. and return
the appraisement under their hands to the Court.
