Ordered that John Clayton, John Vick and Richard Stephenson or any two of them examine the State and settle the account of the administration of the Estate of John Vick deceased and report thereof to the Court.

The last will and Testament of John Williams deceased was proved by the oaths of Benjamin Broadshaw and Thomas Hunsley two of the next of kin and is to be recorded.

Ordered that James Vick, Amos Stephenson, Thomas Atkinson and B. Bennett or any three of them, being first sworn by a Justice of the Peace as well and truly appraise in Current money all the personal Estate of John Williams decd and return the appraisement under their hands to the Court.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County into whose hands the Estate of James Atkinson decd hath been committed, pay to John Drake the sum of three dollars and fifty cents with interest thereon to the Comptroller after the rate of Six per centum per annum from the 13th of December 1814 till paid, the amount of the 62 Cts. Costs of motion and return an account thereof to the Court.

Samuel Pomeroy who has been summoned to give Counter security for his suretyship of Abraham Broadshaw, orphan of William Broadshaw decd, this day appeared and together with John Vick his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars Conditioned as the law directs. Whereupon Samuel Pomeroy his former security for the suretyship aforesaid, from this time is discharged.

Ordered that the overseers of the poor, bind out Henry Byrd and Samuel Byrd poor children according to law.

James Tiller is by the Court appointed guardian to his son James. Whereupon the said Tiller together with Samuel Braughley and Lawson Braughley his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars, Conditioned as the law directs.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County and Comptroller of the Estate of James Atkinson decd pay to Giles Barrett administrator of James Atkinson decd the sum of one dollar with interest thereon from the 13th of Decr till paid, also 62 Cts costs of motion and return an account thereof to the Court.

Christopher Lee produced to the Court the Sheriff's receipt for the Tapping of his barbers and Pedlars, Therefore it is ordered that he have Receipt to this time within this 1st day of May next.

An Inventory and appraisement of the Estate of John Davis decd this day returned and is to be recorded.
