Scott, and Elisha Joyner, who being duly sworn and sworn the truth to upon the space sworn, found on the motion of the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth, who moves the Court to instruct the Jury that the defendant Lucy Corbitt, had no right or authority to sell her goods by retail, to her agent when sold, under and by virtue of the license granted to her husband Joshua Corbitt decd., which said the Court refused to give, the Court being divided in opinion whereupon the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth excepted, filing his bill of exceptions which were signed and sealed by the Court and the Jury brought them into Court in the word and figure to wit, "We the Jury find the defendant guilty."
