Scott, Elisha Joyner, Mrs. Fairclough and Benjamin Spivey who being elected true and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue in the aforesaid plea brought here into Court a verdict in the words and figures following to wit, "We of the Jury find for the Pl. that the sum of \$32 with legal interest thereon from the 25th of December 1809 till subject to account of \$4.50 paid on the 12th of August 1809 further find that the defendant hath fully administered the which have come to his hands to be administered" Therefore considered by the Court that, the Plaintiff recover of the defendant the sum of thirty two dollars with legal interest thereon from 25th day of December 1809 till paid the damages aforesaid and his costs by him in this behalf expended to be taxed of the goods and chattels of the decedent in the hands of the defendant, to be administered if so much he hath if not, then the costs aforesaid to be taxed of his own proper goods and chattels and the said expenses in money &c.

But this Judgment is of fifteen pounds twelve shillings, 10th day November 1811 till paid and the costs of the decedent and the defendant.
