branch in the Barnes tract of land now a new corner made in Lucy
Corbitts dower, thence along a new line of marked trees, between the
new and Nancy Corbitts Lot No. 1 and Lucy Corbitts Lot No. 2 to a Pine a
new corner made of the dower right and Lot No. 2, thence along the
line of Lot No. 2 and the dower right to a red oak a new corner
made in the dower Lot No. 2 and in Exams Turner out line S. 75. E. 16
pole to a red oak of Exams Turner, thence S. 22. E. 12 Pole variation on
the line thence S. 44. E. 48. Pole to a light wood log lying across the
Cypress swamp opposite the dwelling house, thence down the various corners
of the Cypress swamp to across the road leading from Black water Bridge to
Luridans and so on the run of said swamp to a small Branch, that makes
out of the said swamp, thence along that branch the various corners thereof
to the path that belongs to Major Carr Bowers which path was excepted for
the purpose of and out lot to the road aforesaid, at the time the said
tract of land was purchased, thence along that path N. 65. W. 84 pole

sweet Gum corner of Jonathan Lankford standing in the meadow
branch, thence N. 6. E. 100 Pole to a Pine corner of Amos Bannell at
his fence, thence N. 84. W. 97. Pole to a red post oak corner of Amos
Bannell thence N. 13. W. 12 Pole to a Pine a corner of Amos Bannell near
the side of the road going to Jerusalem as he before described in
his dower right - thence N. 69. W. 70 Pole to a light wood stump
a corner of Bannell at his Bar. N. 24. E. 66 Pole to a sweet Gum a
corner of Amos Bannell standing on the side of the Cypress swamp
thence as long that swamp the various corners to a Black Gum a
new corner in the dower line and a corner for Lot No. 142 thence
along the dower line to the first Station, being Nancy Corbitts
full Proportionable Part of all the lands of her deceased Father -
