Inquest is in these words, to wit: "Aqueally to a Summons from the Sheriff of the County of Southampton we of the Jury met at the Browns mill seat and viewed the lands above and below where is an abutment and mill intended to be made and erected by the said Samuel Browne a Cisp Dick Swamp and Lay that no whatsoever will sustain any injury by the said abutment or mill made either by raising the water or impairing the lands of individuals and the said Browne may hold Twelve feet water he thinks proper, being the usual quantity of grinding of the land formerly, we further say that the said Browne owns in the land on both sides of the said Stream down to the shovels Henry Thomas, Richard Darden, Benjamin Whitfield, George Gurley, John Nick, John Rochelle, John Thomas, James Bishop, James Drake, Alexander Boothe, and James Rochelle. The inquisition returned by the Sheriff, and James Rochelle being the only persons interested, have in Court acknowledged that the said mill may be erected and the said James Rochelle that the said Samuel shall not raise his water so as to overflow the lands of the said James now inclosed for cultivation. It is ordered that said Samuel Browne have leave to erect the

Larry Morrell is by the Court appointed guardian of James Betts and here in Court with Jacob Bannell and Jason Howe he acknowledges a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars as the law directs.
