On the motion of Lilly Johnson, widow and relict of William Johnson and here in Court refuses to take or except of the provisions made by her dead husband in his last will and Testament which is ordered to be entered of record -

Barry Nowell is by the Court assigned guardian to Peggy Betts orphan of James Betts and hereupon the said Barry Nowell together with John Nowell and John Nowe his Securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars, with a condition as the Law directs -
