is heretofore made Certificate is granted the said C. M. Barnes for obtaining letters of
administration on the Estate of Dawson Barnes dec'd in due form, Bolling
and for his Barnes who had the first right to qualify here in Court refused and relinquished
his right to do so —

of Apple brandy on the 19th of May 1848 at his house in the County of Southampton
and within the jurisdiction of this Court to be drunk where sold, with out
having obtained a tavern license for that purpose, by the information of Samuel
James Lee for suffering a negro man slave, belonging to the widow
of the name of Lewis, to retail spirituous liquors, To wit, one half
of Apple brandy on the plantation of said James Lee on the 11th of
May 1848 by the information of William Francis, Michael B Day, Peter
