In Chancery

This cause was this day decided by Court of Chancery and report of
the Court was heard on the bill and answer and argument of Counsel -
whereupon and after due consideration thereof has the Court with advice and
consent that John Williams, Nicholas L. Williams and Benjamin Cobb or
any two of them, do sell to the defendant Polly, one third of the tract
of land whereof Richard Haulcome died seized containing, one hundred
and fifty acres lying in this County for and during the term of her natural
life and for her dower in the same. That they do so the balance of the land
in proper rods and bounds among your Complainants Comme and Matilda
and the defendants, Richard, Nancy, Eliza and Susan Haulcome in case the
same should be worth one hundred dollars a share, and in case the
balance of said land should not be worth one hundred dollars a share
that they or any two of them, do sell the same at Public Auction on
a tract of Twelve months, after giving three weeks public notice of the
time and place of sale, that they divide the proceeds of the sale into six
equal parts taking bond with approved security for the payment of each
separate part and assign one bond to the Complainant Comme and
the Complainant Claiborn Scott and Marta his wife in right of her
wife, and one to the guardian or guardians of each of the infant
defendants Richard, Nancy, Eliza and Susan Haulcome. That they or
any three of them, after giving like public notice the Slave Mason
and her children, Dred, Amanda, Davy and Amy mentioned in the bill
on a tract of Twelve months, that they take a bond with approved security
for one seventh part of the proceeds and assign the same to the said Richard Haulcome
for his interest in the same as the widow of the said Richard Haulcome
that they divide the balance of the amount of sales into six equal
parts taking bond with approved security for the payment of each separate
part, and assign one bond to each of the Complainants, and the guardian
or guardians of the infant defendants as before directed in the case of the
land. That in case the land be sold, that they make a conveyance in fee
simple to the purchaser or purchasers, and finally, that they render to this
Court a report of their proceedings herein in order to a final decree

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
