Edwards, John Moore, William Wiliford, Benjamin Williams and John Perry, who being elected tried and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue found brought there into Court a verdict in the following words To wit "We of the Jury find for the Plaintiff and give him damages to Twenty five dollars with interest from the 25th of December 1814 till paid". Therefore it is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover of the defendant the sum of Twenty five dollars with legal interest thereon from the 25th of Decr 1814 till paid the damages aforesaid in form of assent and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended — and the said defendant in money \$6 —
