This day came the parties by their attorneys and thereupon came a Jury  
with John Thomas, James M. Parker, Matthew Barrett, Abraham Wilkins,  
David Davis, David Vallance, Presley Barnes, Benjamin Williams, Elijah Ferry,  
William Williams, Jesse Barrett and John Newell, who being elected tried and  
the truth to speak upon the issue joined brought there into Court  
in the following words, To wit, "we of the Jury find for the Plt.  
the sum of seven pounds with interest from the 17<sup>th</sup> day of Decr 1795. and as  
subject to the credits incurred upon the specialty, we further find that the deft.  
has fully administered the assets which have come to his hands to be administered  
except as to the sum of £9.99 with Int. thereon from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1811  
which said sum of £9.99 with interest as aforesaid is now due to the Plaintiff  
before it is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover of the deft.  
sum of Seven pounds with legal interest thereon from the 17<sup>th</sup> day of Decr 1795  
to pay the debt in the declaration mentioned and his costs him about his suit  
his half expenses and the said defendant in mercy &c. To be paid of  
the defendant's goods and chattels of the assets when sufficiently thereof shall come to his hands  
to be administered but if not then the costs aforesaid to be paid of his own  
goods and chattels, But this Judgment is to be credited for the sum of  
one pound twelve shillings paid 20<sup>th</sup> of April 1797. also one pound ten shillings  
paid 10<sup>th</sup> Aug. 1797
