

On the account of the administration on the estate of James Perkins

On the motion of John Williams, It is ordered, that the value of certain
goods and the Commission to the hands of the Sheriff of this County and it is
ordered that he take charge of the same and dispose thereof as the law directs

On the motion of Joshua B. Lumsay, It is ordered, It is ordered that

and his Successors in office for the time being, for the use of the Commonwealth
under yet upon this Condition that, if the said Bailey Turner shall
make her personal appearance before the Judge of our next Superior
Court, to be holden in and for the County of said on the first day of
the Court by 10 O'clock of that day - A.M. then and there to abide and
perform the order and judgment of that Court, and shall not depart thence
without the leave of the Court, then this recognizance to be void or else
to remain in full force and virtue,

Be it remembered that John Brown with Brunner Brown and Harrison
Griffin his Securities here in Court acknowledge themselves indebted
unto his Excellency James P. Preston Esq. Governor or Chief Magistrate of this
Commonwealth, in the said John Brown in the sum of one hundred dollars
and his said securities in the sum of fifty dollars, each, take oath of their
respective goods and chattels lands and tenements, to the said Governor
and his Successors in office for the use of the Commonwealth, under yet
upon this Condition that if the said John Brown shall be of good behavior
and keep the Peace towards all the good Citizens of this Commonwealth for the
space of Twelve months from this day, but more especially towards Alfred
Berry of this County then this recognizance to be void or else to remain
in full force and virtue

Be it remembered, that Alfred Berry, with Bailey Berry and
William Montford, here in Court, acknowledge themselves indebted unto his
Excellency James P. Preston Esq. Governor or Chief Magistrate of this Common-
wealth in the said Alfred Berry in the sum of one hundred dollars
