were sworn as follows, "An Indictment agt. Spencer M. Jenkins as true bill
was present John T. Blow surveyor of the road, from the Bridge at Jerusalem
to the fork of the road near New Brothers, for not keeping the same in repair
within the last six months and being within the jurisdiction
of this Court, by the information of Nathan Britt and William J. Britt two of
the grand jury having nothing further to present were
discharged

Ordered that the sheriff of this County, into whose hands the Estate of
James Newson dec'd hath been committed, pay to James Newson the sum of
two pounds, five shillings with legal interest thereon from the 1st day of
January 1813 till paid also the sum of one dollar and two Cents costs of motion
and return on a writ of habeas corpus paid 1st of April 1814 -
and return an account thereof to the Court -

Ordered that the overseers of the Poor bind out Joseph, James
Sophia and Jincy Jones, poor children according to Law -

Ordered that the sheriff of this County into whose hands the Estate of
John Whitehead dec'd hath been committed pay to Jacob Williams the sum
of one dollar and fifty Cents the amount of his account and to Thomas Vaughan
the sum of thirteen dollars and fifty Cents the amount of his account also
further sum of one dollar and two Cents to each, costs of motion, and return
and account thereof to the Court -

Sept. 1. Bond produced to the Court the sheriff receipt for the tax imposed
on Bonds and Adlans. His therefore order that he have license
to sell goods wares and merchandises of foreign growth and
manufactures from this time until the first day of may next -

Nicholson and Robert Nicholson, surviving obligors of themselves
and Benjamin Warren dec'd have petitioners appointed by the Court of
this County to sell the lands and negroes belonging to the Estate of
Benjamin Warren dec'd for the benefit of Elizabeth Barham

William Joyner and Jane his wife late Jane Barham who is
obligor of herself and Nathan Barham dec'd
James Turner and Richard B. Day of this County here in Court undertakes
that in case he shall be cast in this suit he shall pay and
satisfy the condemnation of the Court or remove his body so prior in execution
