feet to a broken pine a new corner made of the lower in Howell
above out line thence along Seaborn line to a red oak a corner in
the upper line, thence along his line N. 11. E. 266 feet to the corner
of the upper line, thence along the various courses thereof to the
corner containing 560 acres being what we think is right - Given
under our hands this 24th day of February 1818, William B. Chapman,
John Nicholson, Edward Rice - Whereupon it is decreed and ordered
the Court and by consent of the parties, that the foregoing report be held
stable and binding between the parties, and that they bear the costs
proportionally.

The persons appointed heretofore Commissioners to make a partition
of the Estate of Joseph Britto, of John, this day make their report
the following words and figures, To wit; "In obedience to an order of the
Honorable Court of Southampton bearing date December Court 1817 we the
undersigned have sold at public auction the land which Joseph Britto (of
John) did seize and possess of William Bowden became the purchaser
and gave bond with approved security to each legatee pay able in nine
months. given under our hands this 27th day of February 1818, Simon Boykin
William Bowden, Samuel S. Boykin. Whereupon by Consent of the parties
with the assent of the Court it is decreed and ordered that the foregoing
report be held firm stable and binding between the parties and that the
costs be proportionally born between them.

Administration of Trust - Between Samuel Balcutt of the one part
and Henry Welch and James Millikin of the other part, was proved by the
depositions of Charles Jennings and William Welch two of the witnesses thereto and
to be continued.

Ordered that the account of Henry Welch amounting to Eighty Six
and Eighty Cents be certified to the executor of public accounts for his
payment.

Ordered that James Vick, John Vick, and Jacob Barnes as my two
examiners stated and settle the accounts of the administration
of the Estate of Josiah and Zachariah Turgerson dec'd. and make and return
report thereof to the Court.

The account current of the Estate of Diana Pitman dec'd. was
returned and ordered to be recorded.
