expenses attending this deed and proceedings. It is further
ordered that Simon Baykin John Saunders, Elias Drummond and Arthur
Harrison officials as Commissioners, who on any three of them effectuate
the foregoing decree and make due report to the Court in order to a final decree
do make

This day this cause came on to be heard on the plea and answer
and it is ordered, as judged and decreed by the Court, that David Harris
Jr, Benj. Turner and William Smith or any three of them be, Commissions
appointed by the Court to make sale of the negroes, which were
belonging to Sarah Harrison decd. widow and relict of Henry Harrison decd.
and down in the said Henry Est. Vt. China, Dey, Allen, Silvia and Harry
they also proceed to sell the negroes belonging to the estate of Sarah Harrison
Jr, China, Dey, Allen, Silvia and Harry, upon a credit of twelve
months, having first duly advertised the time and place of the same and take
with approved security for the same and divide the proceeds thereof
into eight equal parts, and assign one eighth to Thomas Harrison, one eighth to
Sally Davis (formerly Harrison), one eighth to Henry Harrison, one eighth to John
and Palsey Singleton in right of their mother
(formerly Harrison) and the remaining eighth to David Westrook
guardian of Rebecca Harrison in right of her mother Polly (formerly
Harrison). That the said Commissioners, before paying over the respective
shares as aforesaid will take bond from the bench last mentioned distributees
with good and sufficient security payable to Thomas Harrison
from any legal claims or demands which may hereafter accrue
against him as aforesaid the said bonds so specify they are to pay in proportion
to the amount they have received and that the said Commissioners make their
report to this Court in order to a final decree
