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and Louisa A. Edwards the remaining sixth part share and share alike report thereof to the Court in order to a final decree.

Ordered that Henry Briggs late Sheriff of this County into whose hands the Estate of Solomon Turner dec'd hath been committed, pay to Henry Briggs of Henry Sulphur dec'd the sum of fourteen dollars and ten Cents with interest thereon from the 1st of October 1816 till paid when apts. shall be made his hands also one dollar and two Cents Costs.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cold, do examine and settle the account of the administration of the Estate of Henry Sulphur and return an account thereof to the Court.

The last will and Testament of John Harris dec'd was proved by the oaths of Joseph Williams one of the subscribing witnesses, who together with James Harris and John W. Duffies being sworn, deposed to the contents of said will and who are since dead, that the same is in their own hands writing, Whereupon it is ordered that the said will be read in open Court to take upon himself the burden of the execution thereof And on the motion of Joseph H. Thorp - who made oath thereto together with James Harris his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Twenty thousand dollars Conditional as the direct Certificate is granted the said Joseph H. Thorp for obtaining of administration on the said dec'd Estate with his will annexed in due form.

Ordered that James Myrick, Edward Lund as well as Jolly and Thomas Williamson or any three of them, being first sworn by a Justice of the Peace do well and truly appraise in Court money all the personal Estate of John Harris dec'd and return an appraisement under their hands to the Court.

On the motion of Thomas Browne who made oath and with George Guley and Drury Bryant his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Eight thousand dollars Conditional as the Law directs Certificate is granted the said Browne for obtaining of letters of administration on the Estate of Elizabeth Browne dec'd in due form.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Faircloth, do examine and settle the account of the administration of the Estate of John Brown dec'd and report thereof to the Court.

Ordered that Dixon Ferguson J. or any three of them, being first sworn by a Justice of the Peace do well and truly appraise in Court the personal Estate of Elizabeth Browne dec'd and return an appraisement under their hands to the Court.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cold, do examine and settle the account of the administration of the Estate of Alfred H. and return an account thereof to the Court.

Henry Brier a free woman of the Sheriff of this County into whose hands she was committed, charged with feloniously stealing two books the property of Court House of this County, the Court summoned her and thereupon did examine witnesses sworn to the same touching the premises, testimony and all of the circumstances and the Court is of opinion that Brier is not guilty and therefore from her imprisonment and further prosecution.

Matilda Gardner a free woman of the bar by the Sheriff of this County committed, charged with feloniously carrying away two pocket books the property of the Sheriff of this County, the Court for their own witnesses were sworn and examined touching the premises, and the witnesses after hearing the testimony and all of the circumstances and the Court is of opinion that Gardner is not guilty and therefore it is ordered that she be released from her imprisonment and further prosecution in this behalf.
