Ordered that Worthington Ellis be summoned to March Court next
In this cause if any he can why he should not be fined in the sum of
\$100.00 for failing to attend this Court as a Grand Jury when summoned

Ordered that Master Commissioner Faircloth, examine Slave and settle the
account of the administration of the Estate of Robert James dead, as well the account
of the administration of the Estate of Solomon Dawson dead, also the account of the
administration of the Estate of Richard Blunt with his wife Martha P. Blunt, orphan of William
Blunt dead, and also the account of Matthew Garner, guardian of the Estate of
John Rochelle dead, and make separate reports thereof to the Court -
