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bond each of the distributees viz: one to Joseph Hill in right of his wife Martha, one to William Gray, one to Thomas Gray and the remaining one to Elizabeth Gray otherwise Elizabeth Miller or their heirs, and make application to this Court in order to a final decree.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Faircloth, do examine and settle the account presented of the administration of the Estate of David Turner deceased and report thereof to the Court.
