William Williams and Britton Williams sons of Nathan Williams decd. Defendants
This Cause was this day docketed by consent of parties and agent of the Court
to be heard on the bill, answer and arguments of counsel, whereupon
after due consideration thereof had the Court doth assign order and decree
that Laurence Cook, William Phillips, Jacob Barnett and William Bryant, do
apart and allot to the defendant Polly Williams one third of the land and
the slaves in the hands of the Defendant Britton Bryant which were of the
estate of Nathan Williams decd. having regard to their value for and during the
life of her natural life the said Polly executing to the said Britton Bryant
a refusing bond as the law requires provided he insists upon it that they
any of them, do divide the balance of said land and slaves equally having
regard to value between the Complainants Miles and Joel Williams and William
Whitfield and Rebecca his wife the said Complainants and William Whitfield exe-
cuting to the said Britton Bryant such a refusing bond as the law requires
and the said Britton Bryant insists upon it. And it is further ordered that
any of them as may act, do make a report of their proceedings therein in
writing to a final decree

Upon the petition of Miles Eley setting forth that he is desirous of erecting a
mill upon the land owned by the said Miles Eley by his attorney and Simon
proprietor of the land owned by the said Eley to be liable to damages having
been summoned to appear here on this day. were solemnly called, but came not
in consideration of the inquisition returned by the Sheriff at the last Court
and fully hearing the petitioner and all the circumstances being weighed, it is
ordered that the said Miles Eley have leave to build the said mill and dam,
in fee simple of the one acre of land in the said inquisition
located upon his paying the valuation thereof and the damages found
thereby to the several parties entitled thereto
