The commissioners heretofore appointed to make sale of the land of William
do decree this day make their report in the word and figures following To wit
the 15th day of July 1808, directed to us, Commanding us to make sale of a
tract of land, which a certain William Griswitt of said County, died seized
and after, advertising the said tract of land agreeably to Law, we
did expose it to public sale of 12 Months Credit to the highest bidder, and obtained the
sum of one hundred and seventy prime dollars which said sum we have allotted
paid over to the Complainants James Griswitt, Adolphus Griswitt in right of his
Elizabeth but in right of her mother. Bangoine Cobb, Elizabeth Cobb and
they in right of his wife Rhoda Eley formerly Rhoda Cobb and Anthony Cobb
right of their mother each their respective parts of the said sale, agreeably to
said decree. Given under our hands and seals this 5th day of September 1818 —
Dated 5th Sept 1818 — Whereupon it is decreed and ordered that
James report be held firm and stable between the parties and that the costs be
personally born between them — and that the same be entered of record —

An account current of the estate of Rebecca Briggs deceased was this day returned
and ordered to be recorded —

Ordered that Henry Briggs late Sheriff and Commissioner of the Estate of Nathaniel Barham
pay to Elizabeth V after the sum of Two hundred dollars, with a deduction of Six
cents, and after the 25th day of December 1819, when the same shall come due, also the sum
of two hundred dollars with legal interest from the 25th day of December 1816 till
paid, also the sum of two hundred dollars with legal interest thereon from the 25th day of
December 1817 till paid the amount of his several notes and accounts, and account
with the Court — also the sum of One dollar and two cents for the costs of this motion

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb, examine State adjust and settle an
account of Henry Briggs transactions on the estate of Samuel Briggs a decedent, which
is committed to him by this Court. in pursuance of an act of assembly concerning decedents
to the Court —

On the motion of Henry Briggs who made oath and together with William
and Thomas Gray his Securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the
sum of Fifty thousand dollars Conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted
to Henry Briggs for obtaining letters of administration De bonis non on the
estate of John James decd. in due form —

Ordered that John Davis, Jeph Wick and Joseph Wick or any two of them
examine, State adjust and settle the account of the administration of the estate of
Barner deceased and report thereof to the Court —
Ordered that Henry Briggs late Sheriff and Commissioner of the estate of Willis Williamson
pay to Charles Cook the sum of Ninety shillings eleven pence half penny the
cost of his account also the sum of one dollar and two cents costs of motion and
an account thereof to the Court —
