This Cause was this day docketed by Consent of parties and opened by the Court. Arguments of [unclear] were heard on bill answers and arguments of Counsel, whereupon and after due consideration thereof had the Court doth acquiesce over and decree that John & George, Nicholas & Thomas Boykin and John Holmes or any three of them, do with the assistance of Henry Barron the County surveyor lay off and set apart by proper metes and bounds one third of the defendant's lands lying in this County of which William Washington died seized having the appraised value, and allot the same to the Complainant Peggy Washington, for and as her dower during her natural life as and for her dower in the same. It is further decreed that each of them or any three of them, do allot to the said Complainant and Peggy Washington one third in value of the dower which now are of the estate of the said William Washington and for and during the term of their natural life and finally it is ordered that they or such of them as do set forth and make a report to this Court of their proceedings herein in order to a final decree.
