and after due consideration thereof had It is decreed and ordered that the defendant deliver over to the Complainant the slaves in the bill mentioned as one now living and their increase, and it is further decreed and ordered that the defendant render before one of the Commissioners of this Court an account of said slaves from the time they were in the possession of the defendant & report any matter or thing thought pertinent by himself or required to be by the parties and that the defendant pay the Costs of this Suit &c.

Whereas that Henry Briggs late Sheriff of this County into whose hands the Estate of John Turner deceased hath been committed pay to John Turners the sum of fourteen and fifty one Cents the amount of his account also one dollar and two Cents the amount of this motion and account therefor with the Court.

Whereas otherwise called Kichen Turner a free man of Color was this day taken by the Sheriff of this County into whose custody he was committed charged with having stolen and carried away two turkeys of the value of one dollar and fifty Cents (The Court summoned for his examination not having met) and upon due witnesses were sworn and examined on behalf of the Commonwealth upon the premises to wit, Thomas Woodward and Rhoda Buck. The Court hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner is not guilty and thereupon proclamation being made as the law is and nothing further appearing or being alleged against him It is ordered that he be discharged from this prosecution.

Whereas that the Court be adjourned until Court in Course
